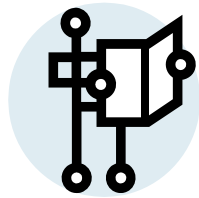

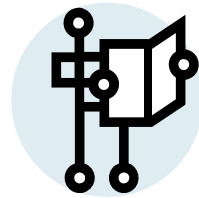
Clergy & Employees

What is each Bishop, Priest, Deacon or Employee required to do:

1. Successfully complete the Live Scan Fingerprint background check process.
2. Attend a workshop or successfully complete online training from the internet for Protecting God's Children for Adults. Keep a copy of your certificate for reference.
3. Read monthly bulletins from Virtus. Be sure to answer the question at the end of each bulletin.
4. Read the supplemental documents found either online or included in the Participants Workbook in the for:
 - the Diocesan Safe Environment Policy,
 - Code of Pastoral Conduct,
 - California Child Abuse and Neglect Reporting Law.
5. Where applicable, assure that every child - K through 12th grade-attends a personal safety training program that will help them be safe from those who might harm them.

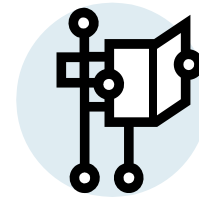
Volunteers who have regular contact with children

What is each Volunteer required to do:

1. Successfully complete the screening background check process (Screening One).
2. Attend a workshop or successfully complete online training from the internet for Protecting God's Children for Adults. Keep a copy of your certificate for reference.
3. Read monthly bulletins from Virtus & answer the question at the end of each bulletin. (All Religious Education and Youth Ministry Volunteers)
4. Read the supplemental documents found either online or included in the Participants Workbook in the for:
 - the Diocesan Safe Environment Policy,
 - Code of Pastoral Conduct,
 - California Child Abuse and Neglect Reporting Law.

Recommended for Volunteers:

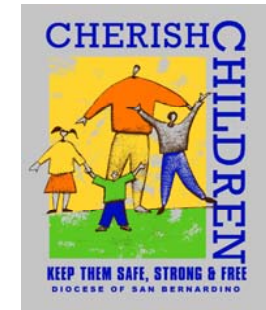
